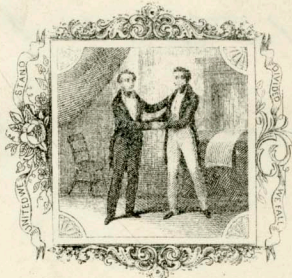

Little Rock Ark:

Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt of a communication from yourself and Lieut Gov^o Smith informing me that the General Assembly of Arkansas had passed or adopted a memorial to the Congress of the United States in relation to bounty to certain colored persons and requesting me to present the same to the legislature of Kentucky for their action. If you will favor me with an official copy of the memorial I shall be happy to comply with your request. The copy inclosed by you not being the memorial which

passed the Legislature of your State but
one prepared for action by the General as-
sembly of this State.
