Urbana Ohio July 17th 1874
 To the Hon Gov Baxter of Ark

Passing through Ohio from Memphis I find a Paper containing the full text of the new Constitution as adopted by the Constitutional Convention of Ohio 14th of May 1874, which will be adopted, or rejected by the People, 18th of Aug next;

Thinking that said document might be of service to the Constitutional Convention of Arkansas I send you the Cir Gazette containing the same

Please accept my sentiments of high esteem for yourself, and expression of sincere hope that a Constitution will be prepared by the Convention recently elected, and adopted by the People that will secure the Rights and Liberty of every Citizen of Ark,
