WARRANT dated *Dec 21st* 187*5* returned non est *G. W. McIntosh* by *March 12 1876*

At *14* days endeavoring to arrest, from *Jan'y 20th* to *Feb'y 2d* inclusive **DOLLS.** *38* **CTS.** *10*

Mileage on writ *235* miles, at 6 cents per mile. **DOLLS.** *141* **CTS.** *10*

Actual expenses *23* days feeding prisoner from *Jan'y 20th* to *Feb'y 2d* inclusive **DOLLS.** *50* **CTS.** *00*

Mileage returning *235* miles per deputy *235* miles per mile at 10 cts. per mile **DOLLS.** *23* **CTS.** *50*

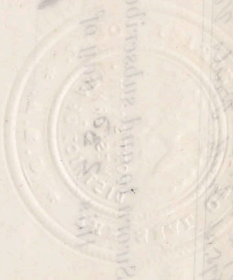
