To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS

John William Williams of Township 10 North Range 10 West in the District of Columbia
deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at *Washington* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *John William Williams* according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for *the North West quarter of Section 36 Township 10 North Range 10 West in the District of Columbia subject to a Washington, Kansas, containing eighty acres*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John William Williams* NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *John William Williams* and to *his* heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *John William Williams* and *his* heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I

PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the CITY OF WASHINGTON, the *fourth* day of *April* in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *thirty seven* and of the INDEPENDENCE OF THE UNITED STATES the *sixty first*
