Clarendon March 31st 1841

W. Sir John R. Dye the bearer of the
 commissions for this County has either
 neglected to hand me my commission
 as Justice of the Peace or I have lost
 it since I received it. He says he gave it
 to me but I have no distinct recollection
 of it. At all events an examination
 for it to take it to the Clerk's office for
 filing I cannot find it and I know of
 no other mode of getting another but
 by informing and getting it from you
 you will please forward me another
 immediately if consistent with law
 To his Excellency I am Sir y^{our} most
 Obedient Servant
