State of Arkansas," to take place at the Court-house door of said county on the ~~14th~~ <sup>third</sup> Monday of ~~January~~ <sup>February</sup>, A. D. 1846 and the lands

The Clerk of \_\_\_\_\_ county will record the notice referred to in the above affidavit, and immediately following it will record the affidavit. The Sheriff should be credited by the amount of State and County taxes charged in the tax book on the lands and town lots embraced in the list filed with the Clerk, in accordance with section five of the revenue act, approved 8th Jan., 1845; and should be charged with the amounts of the State and County taxes and the penalty thereon, as stated in the published notice of the sale.

After the sale, the Clerk will, in accordance with sec. 89 of chap. 128, "Revised Statutes of Ark's," make out, certify and forward to this office a complete transcript of the record of all the lands and town lots advertised for sale, showing what disposition was made of them.—The Sheriff, as required by sec. 101 of chapter 128, "Revised Statutes of Ark's," will, immediately after the sale, make out a correct list of all lands and town lots forfeited to the State at such sale, under his hand, and the Clerk will attest and record the list as required by law, and the Sheriff will then forward such list to this office. The law requires the two lists to be made out and recorded as above stated, and it is hoped the Clerk and Sheriff will furnish them accordingly.
