Whereas, it appears by the annexed documents, which are hereby certified to be authentic,
that James Holland

stands charged with having in his possession a counterfeit Gold
Coin with intent to defraud or injure by uttering

the same as true or false, committed in the State of Alabama, and information

having been received that the said James Holland

has fled from justice and taken refuge in
Arkansas

THEREFORE, I, A. B. Moore Governor of the State of
Alabama, have thought proper, in pursuance of the provisions of the Constitution and Laws
of the United States, to demand the surrender of the said

James Holland

as a fugitive from justice, and that he be delivered to Thomas M. Peters

who is hereby appointed the agent on the part
of the State to receive him.

GIVEN under my hand, and the Great Seal of the
State affixed at the CITY OF MONTGOMERY, this
8th day of September
A. D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty-nine
and of the Independence of the United States
of America, the eighty- 4th year.
