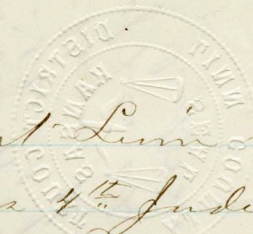

The jurors of the Grand Jury selected from the body of the County of Linn & State of Kansas, duly impanelled, sworn & charged to diligently inquire and true presentment make of all public offences committed within said county, in the name and by the authority of the State of Kansas on their oaths do find & present that one A. A. Rodgers at said County of Linn & State of Kansas on and about the 10th day of August A.D. 1866 and at the town of Mound City in a certain one story frame building being on west 1/2 of Lot No 14 Block No 15 occupied by said A. A. Rodgers used and occupied without having taken out a license as a grocer, dram shop keeper or Tavern keeper, ~~for~~ wilfully sold & gave away to one Joseph Young & others, certain whiskey, spirituous various fermented and intoxicating liquors contrary to
