## **Biographical/Historical Note**

---

Burdet L. Daniel served with the 11th Regiment, Company K, Missouri Cavalry, United States Army, during the Civil War. The 11th Regiment consolidated with the 2nd Regiment in September 1862.

---

## **Scope and Contents**

---

This collection contains a letter written by Burdet Daniel to his brother during the Civil War. Burdet was asking his brother about rumors that Cape Girardeau , Missouri, had been taken by the Confederate military. According to Burdet, a portion of Union troops were defeated by General Sterling Price in Dardanelle, Arkansas, along the Arkansas River around the same time that General Shelby made his raid on Little Rock and the Memphis Railroad. Burdet's diary is seven pages long and was written by him at the end of the Civil War. Burdet kept an account of daily activities from January 1, 1865 - April 25, 1865.
