CHARGE:

Assault with intent to kill in the Indian Country.

WARRANT dated Jan 29 1876. Served by J. A. Vandegriff near Muskogee, C. W. 1876. 1 day endeavoring to arrest, from Jan 29 to inclusive. Mileage on writ 205 miles, at 6 cents per mile. Actual expenses 7 days feeding 1 prisoner from Jan 30 to Feb 5 inclusive. Mileage returning 1 prisoner guards and deputy 5 miles each 10 miles at 10 cts. per mile. Names of Posse Com. Jory Gallagher and Sam McE. Captain Lewis Barnett.

SUBPENAS FOR PLAINTIFF'S WITNESSES SERVED BY ABOVE NAMED DEPUTY,

Table with 5 columns: Date of Subpoena, Miles to, Place of Service, Date of Service, On Whom Served. Includes entries for Jan 29 at Muskogee, C. W. served by H. J. Van Doren, J. A. Anderson, E. F. Witt, J. W. Cummings and Sam McEustance.

Total miles to serve the same at 6 cents per mile.

Attendance of the above name Deputy Jan 31 + Feb 5 1876 before Commissioner.

Committed to Jail at Fort Smith Ark. in default of bail.
