LITTLE ROCK, February 2nd, 1888.

Dear Sir:

Having been called to the position of Deputy Auditor by the late Auditor, William R. Miller, and again to the headship of the Department by the Governor of the State, upon the death of Mr. Miller, in both instances without solicitation or effort upon my part, I feel it to be my duty, in consideration of the premises, to submit my name to the people of Arkansas as a candidate for the office of Auditor of State, subject, of course, to the action of the Democratic State Convention.

It will be impossible for me, in the very nature of the case, to make a close canvass of the State. I therefore adopt this method of advising my fellow-citizens of my candidacy.
