# THE STATE OF ARKANSAS



To All to Whom these Presents shall Come—Greeting:

Know Ye, That I, James P. Clarke Governor of the State of Arkansas, in the name and by the authority of the people of the State of Arkansas, as vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of said State, do hereby appoint and commission J. Gulley a Notary Public, in and for the County of Pulaski in the State of Arkansas, for and during the Term of Four Years, as prescribed by the Laws of the State. He, the said J. Gulley is therefore hereby authorized and required to do and perform all and singular the duties incumbent on him as said Notary Public, in and for the County aforesaid, according to law and the trust reposed in him.



In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Seal of the State to be affixed, at Little Rock, this 23 day of Nov in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and ninety six.
