THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, TO THE MARSHAL OF THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF ARKANSAS---GREETING:

You are commanded to take

John Parham

and *me* safely keep, so that you have *his* body before the Judge of our District

Court of said District, at the United States Court-room in Fort Smith, in said District, forthwith, to answer

the United States of America for contempt of Court, in neglecting to attend before said Court as a Witness,

after having been duly *recognized* thereto.

And that you then and there certify how you have executed this writ.

WITNESS, the HON ISAAC C. PARKER, Judge of the District

Court of the United States, for the Western Dis-

trict of Arkansas, who has caused the Seal of said

Court to be hereunto affixed, this *19*

day of *Oct*, 189*4*, and in the

119 year of our Independence.
