## Historical Note

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The War Time Capitol Memorial Commission was established by Act 274 in 1929, to maintain the Hempstead County Courthouse, which served as the Arkansas State Capitol during the Civil War following the Union forces gaining control of Little Rock. The United Daughters of the Confederacy (U.D.C.) were responsible for the restoration as of 1929. Governors failed to appoint members to the commission until 1939 when Governor Carl E. Bailey appointed commissioners to maintain the building. The members included Mrs. W.H. McCain of Cotton Plant, Mrs. M.L. Gibbs of El Dorado, Dallas T. Herndon of Little Rock, Mrs. Charles S. Lothrop of Hope, Mrs. J.A. Henry of Hope, and W.H. Etter, Jr., of Washington. Mrs. W.H. McCain and Mrs. M.L. Gibbs were ex-officio members of the commission and served as president and secretary of the U.D.C., respectively.
