Biographical/Historical Note

Boone County, Arkansas, located in the Ozark Mountain highlands, was created by the Arkansas legislature in 1869 from a portion of Carroll County and was enlarged in 1875 with the addition of land from Marion County. The county's northern boundary is part of the state line separating Arkansas from Missouri.

Scope and Contents

This collection consists of warranty deeds, pre-emption claim certificates, quit-claim deeds, and deeds of trust issued from 1881-1943 for land in Boone County, Arkansas.
