THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA,

TO THE MARSHAL OF THE WESTERN DISTRICT OF ARKANSAS—GREETING:

WHEREAS, at the District Court of the United States of America, for the Western District of Arkansas,
at the Febry Term thereof, begun and holden in Fort Smith, within and for the District aforesaid,
on the 24 day of Febry, A. D. 1897, the Grand Jurors in and for
said District empaneled, brought into the said Court a true bill of indictment against

Craek Walston

for

R L D

in the Indian Country, against the Peace and Dignity of the United States, as by the said indictment, now remaining on
file and of record in said Court, will more fully appear; to which indictment said

Craek Walston

had not yet appeared

or pleaded.

Now, therefore, you are hereby commanded, as you have heretofore been, in the name of the President
of the United States of America, to apprehend said

Craek Walston

and him to detain and bring before

the said Court at the United States Court-room in Fort Smith, in said District, at the May Term
thereof, to be held on the 7 day of May, A. D. 1897, to answer said indictment.
