Biographical/Historical Note

Russell M. Brooks of Little Rock participated in the Citizens' Military Training Camps program at Camp Pike, Arkansas in 1933. The Citizen's Military Training Camps were military training programs of the United States. Held annually each summer during the years 1921 to 1940, the CMTC camps differed from National Guard and Reserves training in that the program allowed male citizens to obtain basic military training without an obligation to call-up for active duty. The CMTC were authorized by the National Defense Act of 1920 as a compromise that rejected universal military training. Russell Brooks participated in the red course during August 1933. During that time Colonel Harry S. Truman served as camp commander.
