Fort Smith, Ark., Jan., 8, 1895

Having sworn, and examined on oath, the persons hereinafter named, I find that they severally have attended before me as witnesses in the aforesaid case, on the part of the United States, the number of days, and travelled the number of miles hereinafter specified; and that they are entitled therefor to the sum set opposite their respective names.
