Alpha Jane Tackett Hibbard (1843-1906) was born in 1843 to Mt. Etna "M.E." Tackett and Clara Alpha Rollins. Alpha Jane Tackett married Joseph Hibbard and kept a diary during the Civil War documenting life in Arkansas County, Arkansas at that time. Alpha Jane Tackett Hibbard died in 1906.
