YOU ARE COMMANDED TO SUMMON

J. W. Adams
James Brown

That they each and severally, laying aside all business and manner of excuses, appear before the Honorable the Judge of the District Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Arkansas, at o'clock M., on the day of fordwich 188 , then and there to serve as Petch Jurors, and this they will in no wise omit, under the penalty of the laws of the United States in such case made and provided. And of this you will make legal service and due return.

Witness the Honorable **ISAAS C. PARKER**, Judge of said District

Court and the seal thereof, at Fort Smith, in said District, this 11th day of February
