Biographical/Historical Note

The Butterfield Overland Mail Company was established by John Butterfield of Utica, New York, in 1857. He contracted with the United States Postmaster General to transport the mail from the Mississippi River to San Francisco, California, including a major route from Memphis, Tennessee, to Fort Smith, Arkansas, and a route from St. Louis through Missouri and northwest Arkansas, including stops in Fayetteville and Elkhorn Tavern, and ending in Fort Smith, Arkansas.

In 1957 and 1958 the Butterfield and Overland mail celebrated their centennials.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains newsletters, memos, and programs for the Overland Mail Centennial and the Butterfield Mail Centennial between 1957 and 1958.
