To the Marshal of the Western District of Arkansas—Greeting:

YOU ARE COMMANDED TO SUMMON

James O' Daniels
Alfred Coulter
of Fort Smith

That they each and severally, laying aside all business and manner of excuses, appear before the Honorable the Judge of the District Court of the United States, in and for the Western District of Arkansas, at 9 o'clock A. M., on the 14th day of August 1887, then and there to serve as *Petit* Jurors, and this they will in no wise omit, under the penalty of the laws of the United States in such case made and provided. And of this you will make legal service and due return.

Witness the Honorable ISAAS C. PARKER, Judge of said District Court and the seal thereof, at Fort Smith, in said District, this 12th day of August
