For actual absolute and necessary expenses incurred in answering a subpoena to attend as witness before, W.D. Commissioner Stephen Wheeler and the U.S. District Court February Term at Fort Smith Ark, as witness in behalf of the U.S. vs. J.M. Jones charged with murder to wit:

Stage Fare, Fort Sill to Caddo and return	30.00
R. Fare Caddo to Muskogee	15.00
Stage Fare Muskogee to Ft Smith	16.00
Incidental expenses, Ft Sill to Caddo	5.00
" " Caddo to Muskogee	4.00
" " at Caddo and return	2.00
" " Muskogee to Ft Smith and return	9.50
" " ^{two days delay for stage} at Fort Smith	42.00

21 days board 2.00 per day,
Total 123.50
