Asa J. Forgy was born August 11, 1861 to Jackson O'Neal Forgy and Mary Burton Propps. Asa married Martha Paulina (Piney) Briggs and had seven children: Boy O'Neal Forgy; Asa Steele Forgy; Glen Briggs Forgy; Dell O'Dell Forgy; Lt. Colonel and Mary Jean Forgy. He died on March 27, 1941 in Center Point, Howard County, Arkansas.
