## **Biographical/Historical Note**

The death reports in this collection for the years 1867-1870 gives a listing of all the deaths that occurred State Penitentiary, which was built in 1839–1840 in Little Rock, Pulaski County, at the site of what is now the Arkansas State Capitol. After legislation passed in 1899 calling for a new seat of government, it was relocated to a fifteen-acre site southwest of the city, explicitly to make room for the new capitol building.
