WHEREAS, at the Circuit Court of the United States of America for the Western District of Arkansas, at the  
aug term thereof, begun and holden in Fort Smith, within and for the District aforesaid on  
the 15 day of Aug A. D. 1895, the Grand Jurors in and for said District empanelled, brought  
into said Court a true bill of indictment against

Murder

in the Indian Country, against the Peace and Dignity of the United States, as by the said indictment, now remaining on file and of  
record in said Court, will more fully appear; to which indictment said
