Historical Note

The 153rd Infantry, Arkansas National Guard, was organized in 1898 as the First Infantry, Arkansas State Guard. In 1907, the regiment was redesignated the First Infantry, Arkansas National Guard. The regiment remained in the service of the state until June 1917, when it was mustered into federal service for service on the Mexican border. It served there during the disturbances of 1916-1917 and was mustered out in February 1917. The regiment was mustered again into federal service for World War I and redesignated the 153rd Infantry of the 39th Division. The infantry served overseas during World War I, but did not engage in combat. It was disbanded at Camp Beauregard, Louisiana, in January 1919.
