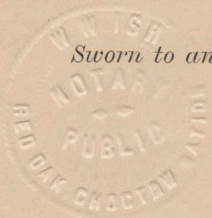

Seaton Thomas, Deputy United States Marshal for said District, being duly sworn, deposes and says that the annexed account for *Seventeen* dollars and *50* cents for services performed and expenses incurred by him from *JAN 1 1897* to *MAR 31 1897*, 1897, is true and correct; that the services therein charged for were actually and necessarily rendered; that the expenses charged were actually and necessarily incurred and paid by him in lawful money; that in each case where an arrest was made the defendant was taken before the nearest circuit court commissioner, or the nearest judicial officer having jurisdiction under existing laws, and that all mileage charged is for travel made with cost to me.
