OFFICE OF U.S. COMMISSIONER, Muskogee, Ind. Ter., April 28 1886 WESTERN DISTRICT OF ARKANSAS. Having sworn, and examined on oath, the persons hereinafter named, I find that they severally have attended before me, as Witnesses, in the aforesaid case, on the part of the United States, the number of days, and traveled the number of miles hereinafter

specified; and that they are entitled therefor to the sum set apposite their respective names.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Marshal pay each of said Witnesses accordingly.
