Biographic/Historical Note

The Ancient Order of United Workmen was established in Meadville, Pennsylvania, on October 27, 1868, by John Jordan Upchurch as a fraternal benefit organization. Each member paid \$1.00 into the insurance fund to cover the sum of not less than \$500.00 in benefits paid to a members descendants when he died. Each time a member died, \$1.00 was due from the surviving members to reestablish the fund. Its international membership numbered in excess of 318,000 in 1895.

This ledger contains lists of officers and official minutes and proceedings of the Ancient Order of United Workmen Lodge in Stuttgart, Arkansas. The dates covered are 1891-1926.
