IN THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT for said District, at a term thereof begun and held at Fort Smith, Arkansas, on the Second day of February 1891. Present: The Honorable ISAAC C. PARKER, Judge, the following order was made and entered of record, to-wit:

WHEREAS, JACOB YOES, United States Marshal, has rendered to this Court an account of his disbursements for Pay of Bailiffs, etc., incurred at and previous to the February term, 1891 at Fort Smith, Ark., of the United States District Court, with the vouchers and items thereof, and in presence of HON. W. H. H. CLAYTON, United States Attorney, has proved, on oath, to the satisfaction of the Court, that the services therein charged have been actually and necessarily performed as therein stated, and that the disbursements charged have been fully paid in lawful money; and whereas said charges appear to be just and according to law.
