### **Biographical/Historical Note**

The National Society of the Daughters of the American Revolution (NSDAR) is a lineage-based membership organization of women. It was founded on October 11, 1890, in Washington D.C. and was incorporated by a Congressional charter in 1896. Their objectives are historic preservation, education, and patriotism. In December of 1893, the first Arkansas chapter was founded in Little Rock. The organization has expanded to about 47 chapters today. The first state conference was held in 1909 and is still being held yearly.

From its formation in 1905, the Arkansas State Archives has actively been collecting materials from the NSDAR. This collection contains a small portion of what the archives holds. Along with our library holdings, we also have many individual manuscripts.
