Biographical/Historical Note

Henderson State University is a public liberal arts university in Arkadelphia, Arkansas. It was founded in 1890 as Arkadelphia Methodist College. The name was changed in 1905 to Henderson College after Charles Christopher Henderson who was a prominent businessman and trustee in Arkadelphia. It was renamed Henderson-Brown College in 1911, to include the name of another trustee, Walter William Brown. It was established as a teachers college in 1929 and renamed Henderson State Teachers College. In 1967, its name changed again to Henderson State College, and finally it became Henderson State University in 1975.

Scope and Contents

This collection contains bulletins, catalogs, programs, newsletters, and other documents related to Henderson State Teachers College, now known as Henderson State University, from 1910 to 1989.
