BOND FOR APPEARANCE OF DEFENDANT BEFORE UNITED STATES COURT.

United States of America, INDIAN TERRITORY,

ss:

Central District,

Know all men by these presents, That we, N. B. Matthews

as principal, and John A. Selser, J. E. Field, A. L. McCarter as sureties, acknowledge ourselves jointly and severally to owe and be indebted unto the United States of America in the sum of five hundred Dollars, to be levied of our goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the said United States of America.

Dated this 2 day of Dec, A. D. 1904

Whereas, The said N. B. Matthews

has been brought before me H. S. Rorer, a Commissioner for the United States Court in the Indian Territory, within and for the Central Commissioner's District of the Central District thereof, to answer the charge of Larceny & Recovery

and upon examination had, it appearing to said Commissioner that the offense with which the said defendant was charged had been committed, and that there was probable cause to believe the said defendant guilty thereof, the said Commissioner ordered the said defendant

N. B. Matthews, to find sufficient bail in the sum of five hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each, for his appearance before the United States Court in the said Territory and District, at a term thereof to be begun and holden on the 13 day of Feb, A. D. 1905, at Ada, in said Indian Territory, to answer what may then and there be objected against him, and that in default of finding such bail defendant stand committed for trial.

Now, therefore, The condition of this bond is such that if the said

N. B. Matthews shall personally appear before the said United States Court at Ada in said District and Territory, on the 13 day of Feb, A. D. 1905, the said day being the 1 day of the next Feb term thereof, and from day to day thereafter during said term, and from term to term thereafter, until finally discharged by order of said Court, and abide the orders of the said Court, and not depart from said Court without leave, then this bond to be void, otherwise to be in full force and effect.
