....., GREETING:

WE COMMAND YOU, That all and singular business and excuses being laid aside, you, and each of you appear and attend before the Judge of the United States Court in the Indian Territory, Southern District, at a Court to be held at the United States Court Room, at ADA..... in the Southern District, in the Indian Territory, on the 10..... day of OCT 1906..... 190..... at 9 o'clock A. M., to testify and give evidence in a certain cause pending in said Court, then and there to be tried, between the United States, as Plaintiff, and Lee Short, Blake Allen....., Defendant, on the part of the United States.

And this you, or any of you, are not to omit, upon the penalty upon you, and every one of you, of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars.
