*Monday* Morning *8<sup>12</sup>* o'clock *May 24* 1886.

Court met pursuant to adjournment: Present—The Honorable I. C. Parker, Judge of the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Arkansas, when the following, among other proceedings, were had to-wit:
