Know All Men by These Presents :

THAT WE, Madron Hunt
as principal, and Belle Starr, Alice Christian
Gaither & Tyson, Amanda M Hunt, Jerry Folsom
and Nathaniel F. Stubbs
as sureties, acknowledge ourselves jointly and severally to owe and be indebted unto the United States of America, in the sum of
One thousand Dollars,

to be levied of our goods and chattels, lands and tenements, to the use of the said United States, if default shall be made in the condition following, to-wit :

WHEREAS, The said Madron Hunt

has been brought before Geo. D. Tufts ~~STEPHEN WHEELER~~, a Commissioner for the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Arkansas, to answer to the charge of Assault with intent to Kill

and upon examination had, it appearing to said Commissioner that the offense with which he was charged had been committed, and that there was probable cause to believe him guilty thereof, the said Commissioner, Geo. D. Tufts ~~STEPHEN WHEELER~~, ordered said

Madron Hunt

to find sufficient bail in the sum of One thousand Dollars,

for his appearance at a District Court of the United States for the Western District of Arkansas, to be holden on the 7th day of February, A. D. 1887, at the United States Court Room at Fort Smith, in said District, to answer what may then and there be objected against him and that in default of finding such bail he stand committed for trial.

NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this recognizance is such that if the said Madron Hunt

shall personally appear at the United States Court Room at Fort Smith, in said District, at 10 o'clock A. M., on the first day of the next February term thereof, and from day to day during said term, and from term to term thereafter, until discharged by order of said Court, then and there to answer what may be objected against him and abide the orders of the Court, and not depart said Court without leave, then this recognizance to be void, otherwise to be in full force and virtue.
