NOTICE, WATER CONSUMERS.

On and after April 1st, water for lawn and street sprinkling will be restricted to 5 hours per day. From 5:30 a. m. to 8 a. m., and 5:30 p. m. to 8 p. m.

Water will be shut off in all instances where rule is not complied with.

RULE 16.—The Company reserve the right, at any time without notice, to shut off the water in their mains, for the purpose of making repairs or extensions, or for other purposes; and all persons having boilers within their premises, not supplied by tanks or cisterns, but depending upon the pressure in the pipe to keep them supplied, are hereby cautioned against danger of collapse.

Extract from an Ordinance

To Provide for the Protection of the Water Company and for the
Punishment of Persons Injuring or Interfering
with the same.

SECTION 168. It is hereby made unlawful for any person to take water from any cock, faucet, hydrant or other apparatus connected with said Water Works, either upon his own or upon the premises of others, unless a license shall have first been issued either to such person by said Fort Smith Water Works Company for such use of water, or to some other covering such use of water by such person.

Any person found guilty of a violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and fined not to exceed the sum of one hundred dollars.

NOTE.---The Water Company agrees to furnish water for certain specified uses, for a certain specified sum. If, therefore, consumers furnish other people, or horses, or sprinkling, or washing wagons, or brick or stone masons, or plasterers, or permit it to be taken without permission from this Company, it is a violation of the contract, and persons so offending will be required to pay full price for the water so used, and the Inspectors of the Company are directed to turn off the supply in all such cases until the matter is adjusted.
