Mag. Jas Bull having [Illegible] us to
Sttate such information as we possess in
relation to the conduct of John Williams
a Justice of the Peace of Warm Spring
Township in Clark County- we regret
to say that his conduct as a Magistrate is
the subject of much complaint in his
County & we believe that he has
not discharged the Duties appertaining
to his Office with a proper regard to the
obligations inforce on him by Law-
his conduct relative to a number
of small suits against Mayr Ball
tried before him was very improbable
manifestations a Distortion to use his
Powers as Magistrate to harass abuse and
[Illegible] his profanity
