Phila., Dec. 22th 1834

Dear Sir

I have a tract of military bounty land which I purchased a few days ago containing one hundred and sixty acres being the South west quarter of section twenty-two, of Township eight north in range three East in the tract appropriated for military Bounties, in the territory of Arkansas, the warrant or patent is in the name of Catherine Adair and the other heirs of James Thompson deceased, Warrant no. 7130 dated at Washington the thirtieth day of April 1821 and recorded Vol 2nd page 163

I should like to know the amount of taxes due on the above lot and also the best method of remitting the same to you an answer will much oblige
