West in the tract appropriated/by the acts of Congress for Military Bounties,
in the Territory of Arkansas granted to Adam Fisher son and the
other heirs at law of Frederich Fisher decd, I therefore apply to you
for the necessary information will you please to inform me by
mail (as speedy as possible) of the amount it will take and
to whom the money is to be send and what kind of money,
your early Answer is respectfully asked
