Sir I am especially solicited to write once more to the Auditor of the Land office at Little Rock for Arkansas on the subject of Military Bounty Lands, I hav wrote twice to the City of Washington and Received answers these to and this makes the third time the I have written to Little Rock and I now hope to git an answer to this in Reply as I hav not here to fore Received any

The Enformation desired is to learn what derposal has been made if any of 160 Acres of Land being the South West qr- of Section thirteen, of township Seven North in Range Nine West, in the Military Bounty Lands of Arkansas as described in a Land warrant whitch I now have in my possession Granted to Asa, Gray, the 20th day of May 1821,, and as all efforts heretofore made now failed to furnish any information in regard these to I hope that your immediate attention will be ceded therefore to it one especial reason why there has not ben earlier attention paid to the Land is that the Said above named Asa Gray has ben absent from the United States about twenty years and has Recently Returned you will there fore confer a favor on him who served in our Countrys Cause, and on me yours most Respectfully
