in pursuance of warrant numbered 25.781
the patent dated 10th August 1825

The other the SE qr of Sec 34 of Township 4 South in
Range 5 West Granted to James Woodward only heir
at Law of John Woodard or Woodward pursuant
to his warrant numbered 26.223
The patent dated 3rd day of November 1829
