Little Rock May 4th 1846

To his excellency John Williamson
acting governor in and over the
State of Arkansas

Sir

The undersigned judge of the county
for Pulaski county would
respectfully inform your excellency
the condition of the yard
around the Capital. Hogs are
nearly all the time in and
sometimes cattle and the
grass and subrery is likely to be
greatly injured. The condition
of poor Treplett is such that he
cannot attend to his duties
therefore I would most
respectfully call your attention
to the same.
