Head Quarters  
28th Regiment Arkansas Militia

To his excellency Thomas S Drew  
Governor and Commander in Chief,

Pursuant to a request of sundry persons proposing to form a Volunteer company under the requisitions of your Excellency I met them on the Eighteenth day of June 1846 at Arkadelphia in the County in Clark When Sundry papers purporting to be Volunteers Lists were placed in my hands.
