Dear Sir

Your communication of the
2nd inst. has just been recieved, in reply I have
to state that in accordance with the act approve
29th Dec. 1848, Section 8 I have issued a writ of
election to fill the vacancy in the office of county
Judge of your county. and consequently until
said election is held, and the person elected qualified
you will have no county Judge-

You wish to know "to whom you all to pay the
county revenue as treasurer of the county" by refering
to the Digest of the statutes of Arkansas- Chapter
138. section 15 &c 24 inclusive you will find that
you are to pay out no moneys except by order of the
county court, hence you can pay out none until
there is a county Judge elected to hold the courts
