You will please examine in your office
and give me a precise Statement of the Situation
of a certain tract of land to wit
N. E. 1/4 of Section 28 in Township 14, North
of Range 1 West, Said tract of land was patented
to one Huie McDaniel, and as I learn has
been forfeited to the State for Taxes, and Taken
up by Nancy Jane Redmond &C
please let know how much taxes &C is now
due on that tract of land and its true Situation
as regards the title &C
