De Witt Arks
October 8th 1855

Mr Auditor

Sir I wrote
you a note a few days since
informing you that our Collector
had failed to give Bond, he still
from some cause neglected his duty
in that respect, But County Court
comes off next week, and in fact
I am looking for the Sheriff out here
tomorrow, I hope he will give Bond
without further delay.

A friend of mine wishes to
know what the condition of the SW qr of
S 11, T 5 S, in R 2 W. and the SE qr of S 34, T 15 North
R 3 W __ is; Will you inform me whether
either of said tracts are subject to Donation
or have they been Donated, is any person
paying taxes on them, how long &c

Any information you can give
me on that subject will be greatly
received by your friend
